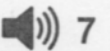


# Lesson 5: Shortnin' Bread (Second Variation)



Here's another way to arrange *Shortnin' Bread* for solo ukulele. This time you'll use a C chord to 'beef up' the sound of the melody. Once again, the goal is to make one ukulele sound like two!

Traditional American

2. Put on the skil - let, slip on the lid,

3 Mam - ma's gon - na make a lit - tle short - nin' bread.

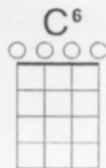
5 That ain't all she's gon - na do,

7 Mam - ma's gon - na make a lit - tle cof - fee, too.

9 Ma - ma's lit - tle ba - by loves short - nin' short - nin'

11 Ma - ma's lit - tle ba - by loves short - nin' bread.

\* Here's how to play C6:



Yes, it's the easiest chord in the world: all four open strings!
