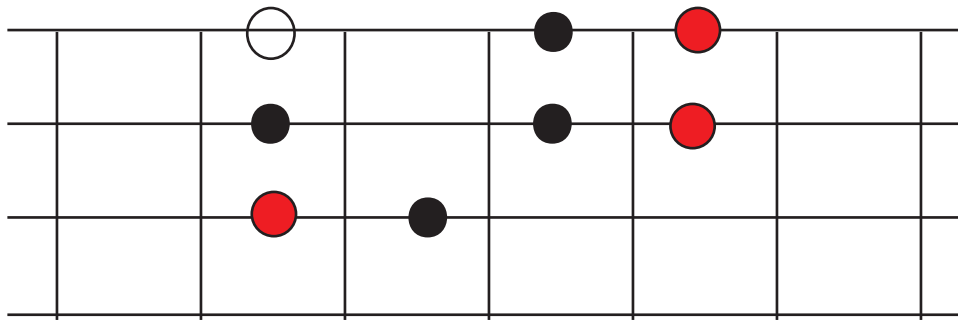


Bump and Box



Bump and box with hot spot

- Indicates which key this shape will fit with. If the note indicated is at the 3rd fret you're ready to play in the C scale. The bump and box with hot spot is primarily for blues.
- Indicates a hot spot, which is an accent note that works with blues. It's usually a note that would change a chord to a 7th or minor from a major chord. Don't stay on these notes too long. They are "hot" to the touch, so use them some but not for long.
